

Installing Icom IC-M412 Simulator Fonts

AWQ training package includes a simulator based on Icom IC-M412 VHF transceiver. To achieve simulator realism, 2 special fonts are installed during setup.

In some cases, it may be necessary to install these fonts by a simple manual process.

After installing the software, run the program (AWQ.exe) and click on "Simulator" then turn it on by rotating the "Volume" knob as you would do with a real transceiver. The Channel Number should look like this:

If what you see is in a different typeface (font), you must proceed with manual installations of the fonts as follows:

Navigate to the application folder you specified during installation. If you accepted the suggested path during installation, it would be the following folder:

[C:\AWQ Training Package \(Beta\)\AWQ\fonts](C:\AWQ Training Package (Beta)\AWQ\fonts)

There are 2 files in the folder:

[LiquidCr.ttf](#)

Select (highlight) each file and click the right mouse button. A pop-up dialog will appear. Click "Install" in the pop up dialog.

That is all...

Re-start the training software (AWQ.exe). The simulator will now show the correct typeface.
